

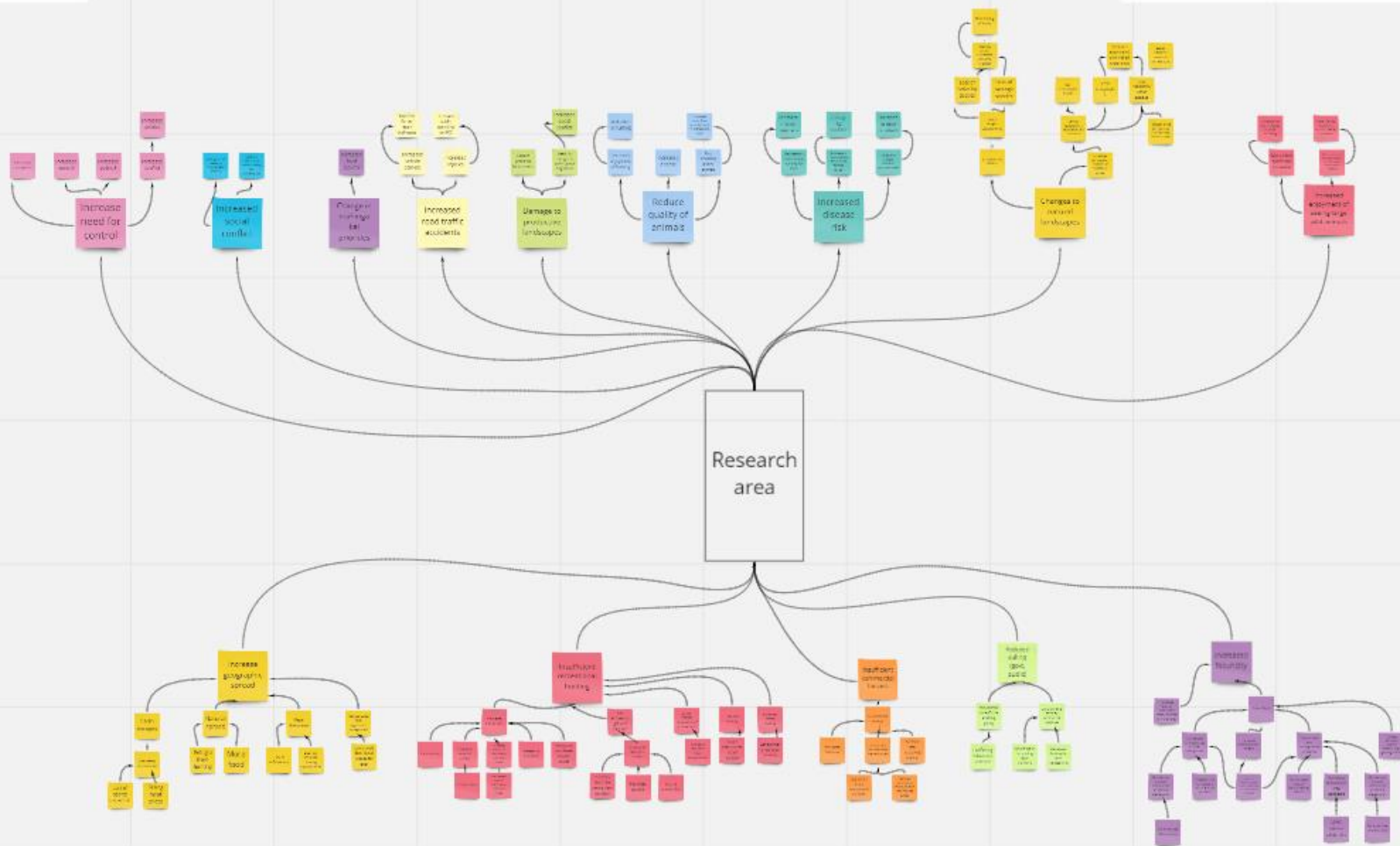

Increased trophy hunting

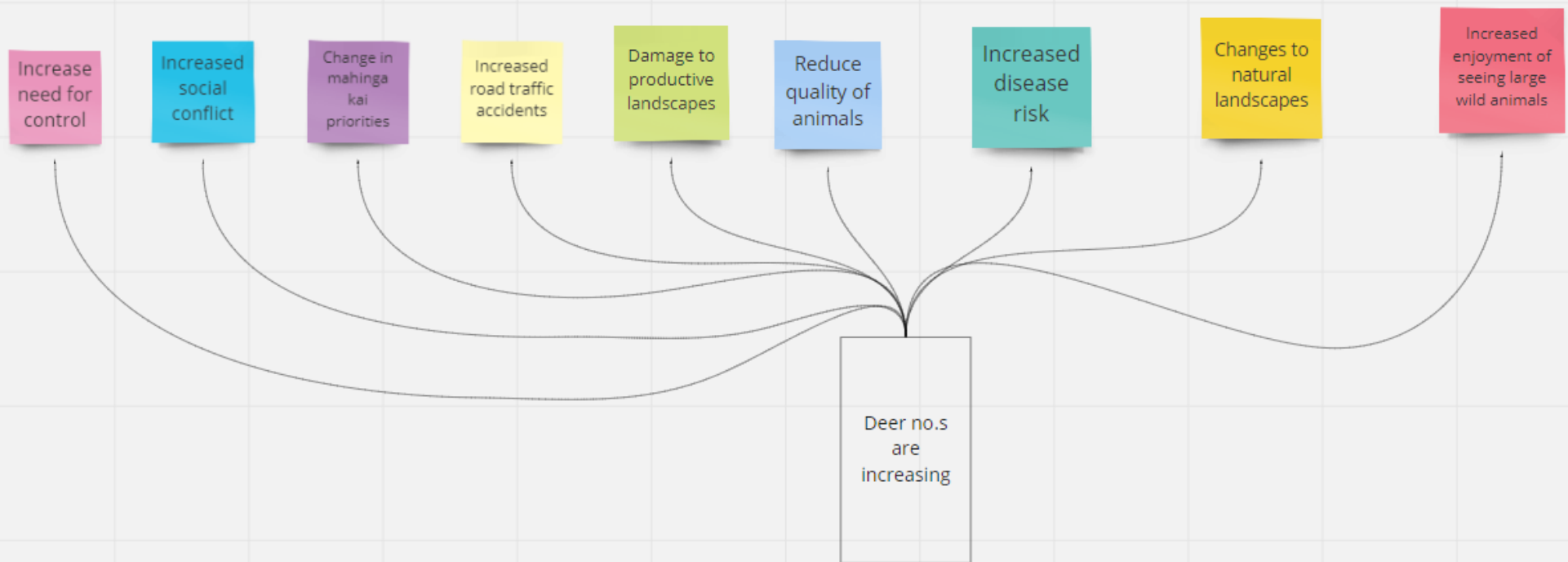

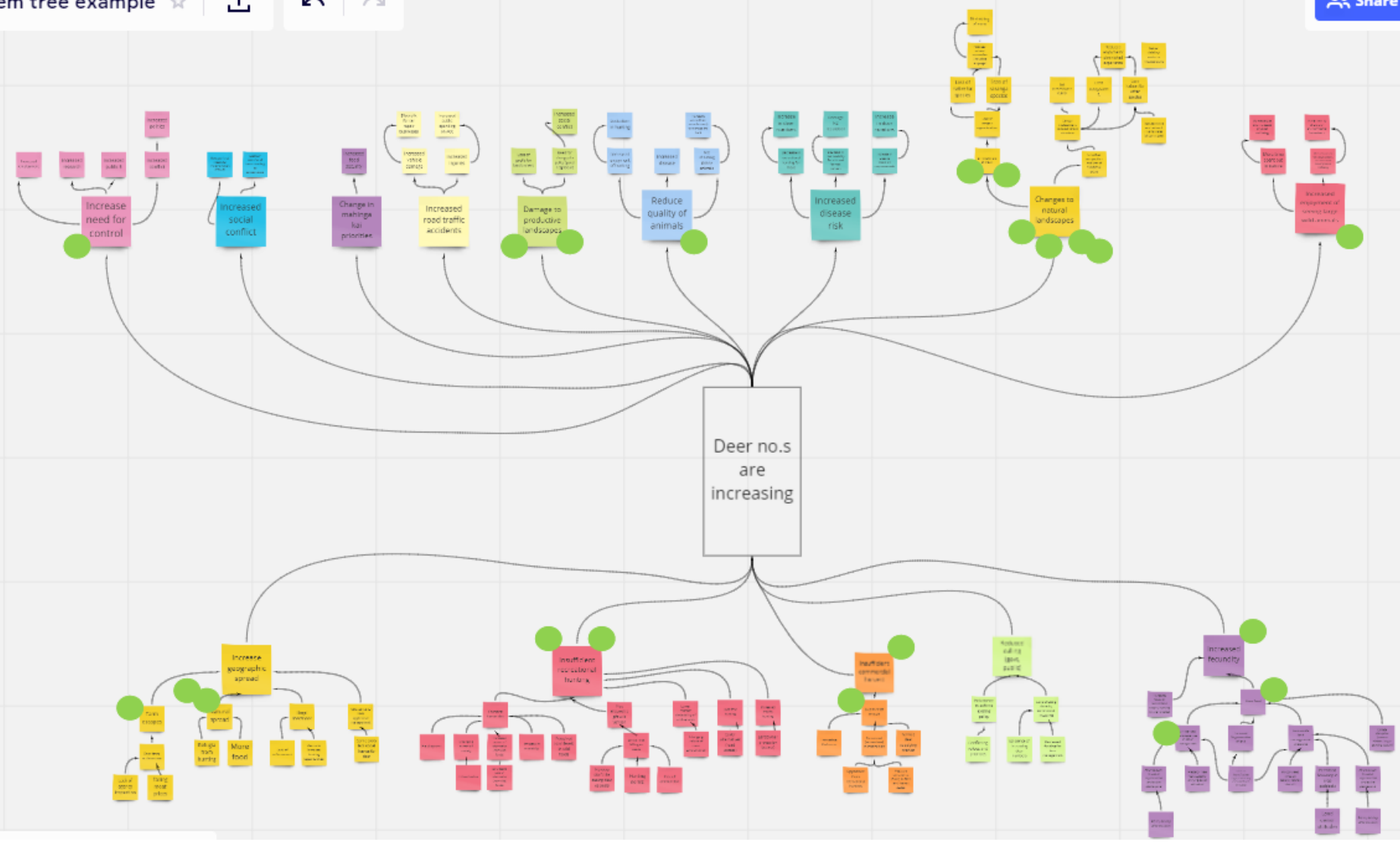


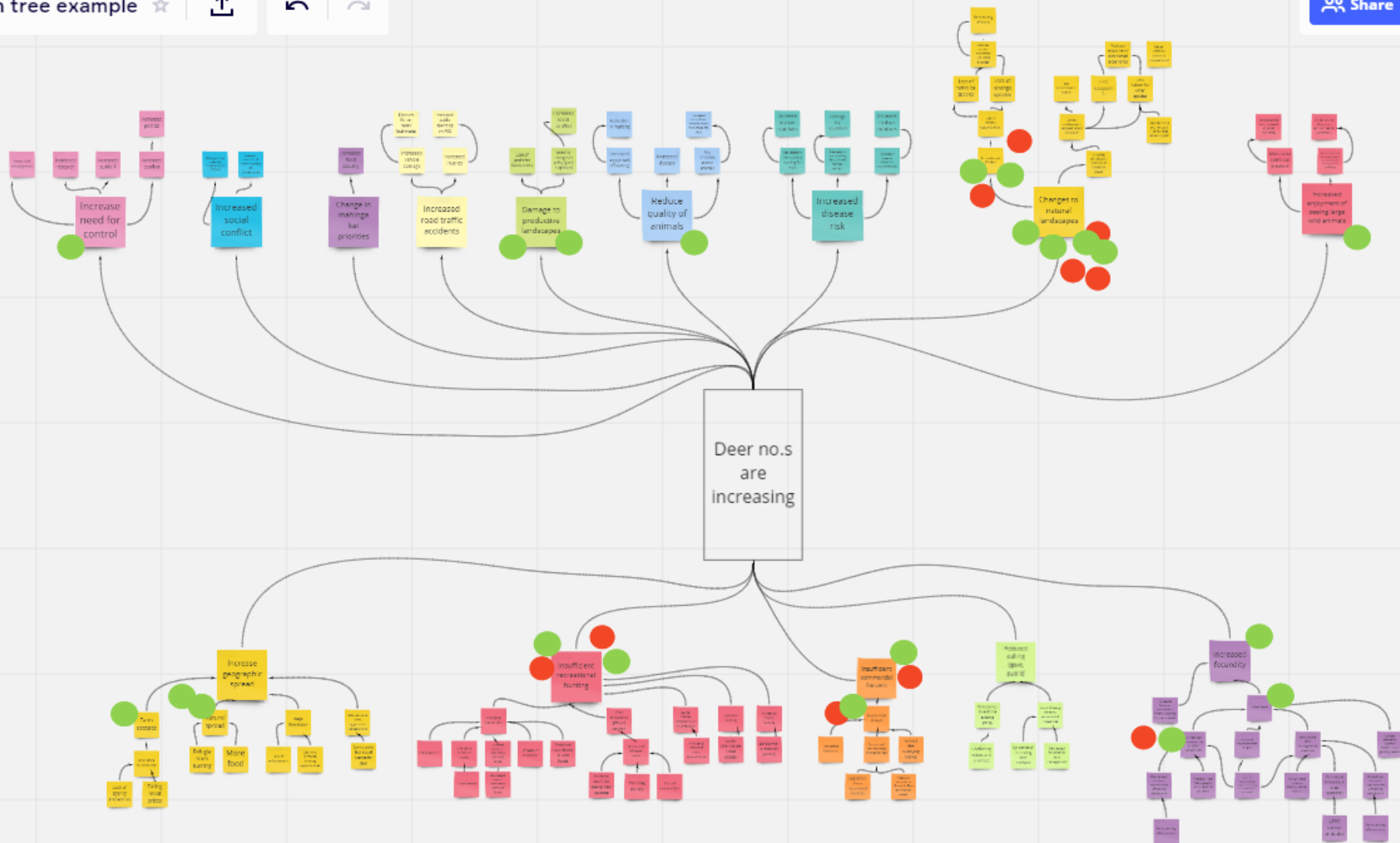
# Unpacking consequences ~ 2
